- 1. Arrival Information:**

If you are not driving, please inform us of your arrival and departure times at Perpignan train station (closest major station to the airport).

- 2. Transport from Perpignan on October 9th:**

For those who are not driving to Fuilla, we provide a shuttle service from **Perpignan train station** to the conference venue for arrivals before 2:30 PM and 4:30 PM. Please inform us if you would like to be picked up and at what time (2:30 PM or 4:30 PM). Dan Winter and/or Eric (the driver) will be present to assist you. On Tuesday, October 14th, multiple shuttles will run from the conference venue to

Villefranche train/bus station. The last shuttle will leave the venue at 11:15 AM.

We can also shuttle up to 9 people directly to Perpignan train station. Please contact us if you wish to use this option.

For those traveling by mini-bus, after the 11:15 AM departure, you may choose to be dropped off at Perpignan train station around noon or join a visit to our favorite local restaurant, Rombeau in Rivesaltes, followed by an optional beach visit to Torreilles (weather permitting). Restaurant expenses are not included in the conference fee; participants will pay individually. The group will return to Perpignan around 4:00 PM.
